

EUROPEAN UNION'S REACH REGULATION DECLARATION CERTIFICATE

The European REACH Regulation 1907/2006 on Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), entered into force in June 2007. REACH affects all companies that produce, import, use, or place products on the European market. The aim of the REACH regulation is to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment from chemical substances.

The substances management system used by KB Electronics, Inc. complies with the current revision of the REACH Regulation as identified by The European Chemical Agency (ECHA). The products produced by KB Electronics, Inc. are considered articles as defined in REACH. These articles under normal and reasonable conditions of use do not have intended release of substances. Therefore, the requirement of registration of substances contained in these articles does not apply.

Products/ Articles provided by KB Electronics, Inc. do not contain any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) candidates listed above the regulatory threshold of 0.1% nor does KB Electronics, Inc. exceed the tonnage of 1 ton per importer per year. Therefore, the requirement in REACH to notify ECHA of articles exceeding these limits is not applicable.

The Reach SVHC List is dynamic and should not be assumed the final REACH candidate list. KB Electronics, Inc. accepts no duty to notify users of this declaration of updates or changes to this declaration.
