Subject Massachusetts Fire Phase II Door Operation with In-Car Stop Switch Activation

Equipment Element, Motion, iControl, Tricon, MCE legacy

Description The state of Massachusetts has determined that, for their jurisdiction, the elevator door

operation must comply with ASME A17.1 section 2.27.3.3.1 when on Fire Phase II, even

when the in-car stop switch is activated.

Action MCE has updated the software for the Motion V8, 9, and 10, as well as the Element

controller. We have confirmed that the iControl software Release 3 and newer is field-configurable to comply with this Massachusetts requirement. There may also be minor hardware changes that need to be made on Motion controllers, depending on the software version. Details will be provided with the updated prints, as needed.

Tricon, MCE Legacy Traction and Hydro controllers need to be reviewed individually, as custom software and/or additional hardware may be required.

Any controller that is currently under warranty will receive the required software/hardware update free of charge. Any controller that is out of warranty will

need to be quoted for the update.
